## Controls and Risks

6. What are engineering controls?

Engineering controls are the use of substitution, isolation, ventilation, and equipment modifications to reduce the exposure to SARS-CoV-2 and the COVID-19 disease related to workplace hazards.

Engineering controls are more effective than administrative controls and PPE. Examples of engineering controls include social distancing, signage, enhanced ventilation with clean filters, and modified office occupancy.

7. What are administrative controls?

Administrative controls are any procedures which significantly limit daily exposure to the virus that causes the COVID-19 disease related workplace hazards and job tasks by control or manipulation of the work schedule or manner in which the work is performed.
