
## **Exporting grades from Remark**






## Importing grades into Canvas

Note: You will import the \*.csv file you received from ITS. Grades are imported using student names only.


1. In the course menu, click on.



2. In the gradebook, click on , , then . . . .




3. Click and open the \*.csv le exported from Remark. Click



Canvas: Importing grades from Remark 4. If Canvas can't nd students or the assignment, you will be prompted to match records to correct students and to create either a new assignment...




...or to choose the existing assignment.




Click . . .
